## Introducción

The Pan American Regional Anti-Doping Organization, PAN-RADO, is the organization officially recognized by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for the protection of clean sport in Latin America through the harmonization and coordination of the anti-doping programs of the associated National Anti-Doping Organizations, and are recognized in Article 21.4 of the 2021 World Anti-Doping Code.

By the end of 2022, PAN-RADO manages to have 11 member countries and 3 strategic partners (Cuba, Mexico and the Dominican Republic) to strengthen the organization for the benefit of play true and the fight against Doping in sport.

### Our member countries:



PAN-RADO continues to strengthen ties between the countries of the region and working hard in the fight against doping. Our goal remains valid as an organization in making member countries feel supported and supported.

This document compiles the different activities carried out by the Pan American Regional Anti-Doping Organization (PAN-RADO), during 2022.

It includes what has been done by the different areas of the PAN-RADO, including the Education area, the Control and Investigation Panel, Results Management and finally the activities in international cooperation and with each member country.

### EDUCACIÓN

In 2022, the PAN-RADO had various educational tools that made it possible to facilitate education for all target groups. These tools allowed athletes, support personnel, doctors, coaches and parents to have a much better understanding of the various issues related to doping in sport.



As the first tool for the target group of children from 8 to 12 years old, the animated series The True Athlete Challenge was being implemented. This animated series already has 7 different episodes that test the values of clean sports.

The children had to identify the different values and qualities that the athletes in the episode had and it gave the opportunity to create an environment of questions and answers, exchange of opinions and final comments by the athletes and the educational staff.

#### **Virtual Game:**

During the year 2021 the virtual game that would complement the animated series was developed and in the year 2022 the use of the Game was promoted through our digital platforms and through all the NADO's.



By the end of 2022, the virtual game managed to have a total of 350 users interacting and playing. For PAN-RADO, the results were positive, since it motivates us to continue implementing new digital and fun tools to reach our members of the sports ecosystem in various ways and raise awareness of the importance of staying clean in sport and promoting equal opportunities.

**Doping Control Simulator:**



The anti-doping control simulator was used in 2022 as a tool to understand urine and blood control processes. This tool could be used to reinforce the knowledge of our doping control officers and could also be used to teach athletes, support staff, doctors, coaches and parents all about these processes.

The tool explains in real time through characters the step by step of the process, allowing an easy understanding of the 11 steps of the doping control process both out of competition and in competition. We achieved a total of 265 visits.

**ADEL Platform:**

The new ADEL platform and educational content are fully responsive to allow users to learn via desktop, laptop, tablet or mobile.



The various courses on the platform allowed different members of the sports ecosystem to learn about various topics depending on the role they play. In other words, there were courses dedicated to doctors, or coaches and of course athletes.

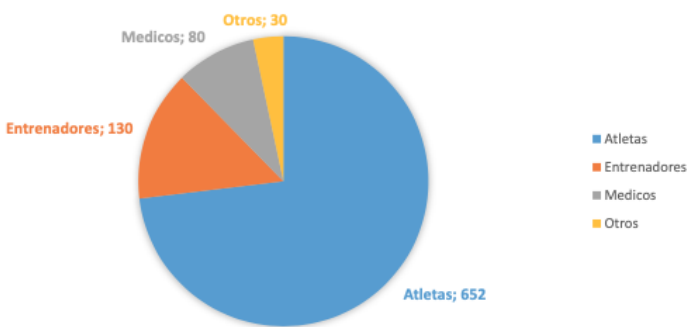

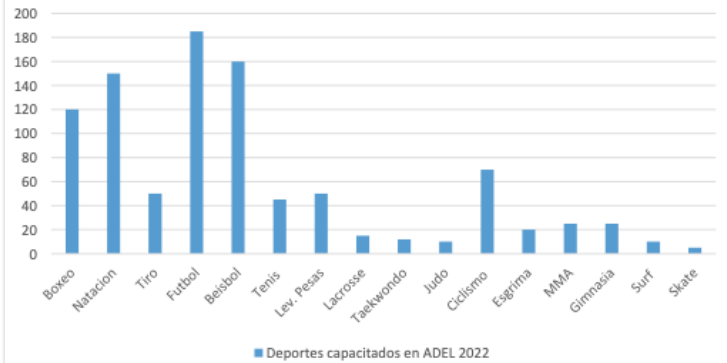
**Grafico de Deportes Capacitados en ADEL PANAMÁ 2022**



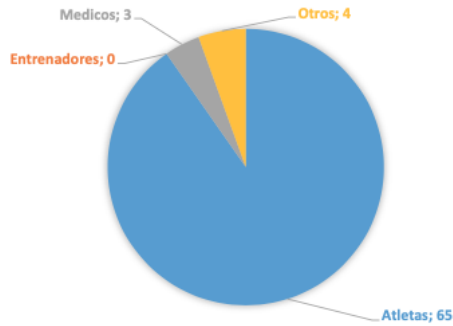
**GRAFICA ADEL PUERTO RICO 2022**



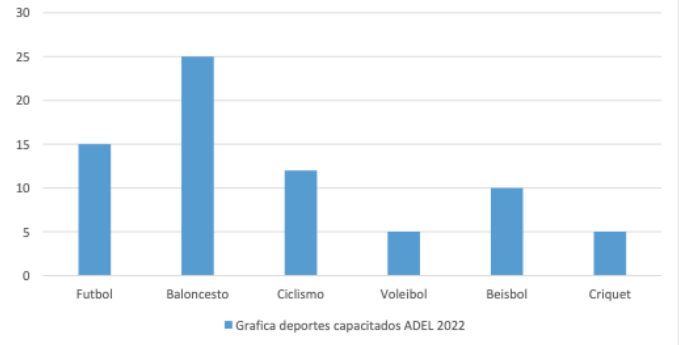

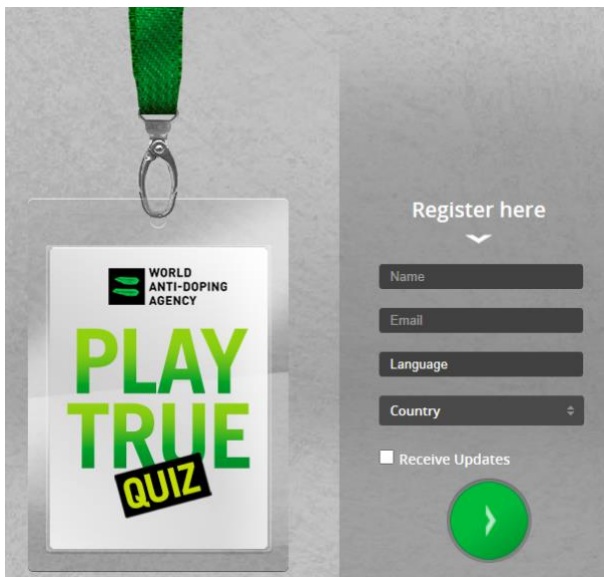




**GRAFICA ADEL BOLIVIA 2022**



### Play True Quiz:



WADA's play true quiz is an interactive computer game that tests your anti-doping knowledge. It is currently available in 49 languages. PAN-RADO was using it in various multi-sport events that were taking place throughout the year in various member countries.

The objective of using the quiz was to have a measurable method to know how much knowledge our athletes and members of the sports ecosystem have regarding anti-doping and in which areas to reinforce in 2023 to improve and increase

that level of knowledge of our target audience.

### Antidoping Education: Educational Trainings.



During 2022, the PAN-RADO work team received training on various anti-doping topics to continue preparing and informing to be at the forefront of information on TUEs, Prohibited List, Control Processes, International Standards, ADEL Platform, and many other important topics that we must know in order to be multipliers of information.

## International and Sport Events South American Games Asunción 2022 – Paraguay



The XII South American Games Asunción 2022 took place in Paraguay from October 1 to 15. The 15 National Olympic Committees that make up Odesur participated in them, and their athletes who competed in 53 sports disciplines, of which 41 are considered Olympic in the next Olympic Games, those of Paris 2024.



The National Anti-Doping Organization of Paraguay, in its continuous fight against doping, was present with an educational stand at the XII South American Games in Asunción 2022, disseminating the most up-to-date and necessary information for all Athletes, coaches, doctors and support personnel who were part of the event and promoting clean sports free of prohibited substances or methods, also putting into practice the knowledge acquired with the Play True Quiz And as part of the training of the Doping Control Officers, the educational tool the Doping Control Simulator was used in the different scenarios that could happen at the time of sample collection.

## IX New Psychoactive Substances and Emerging Drugs

In recent years, there has been a dramatic increase in the number of new psychoactive substances (NPS) detected around the world. The NPS market remains resilient and highly dynamic, characterized by the emergence of a large number of new substances reported in an increasing number of countries. The series, which began in Budapest in 2012, and in this 2022 held in Panama City, aims to share knowledge and strengthen collaboration in NPS among multidisciplinary professionals at an international level to benefit society and improve lives.



It is jointly organized by the International Society for the Study of Emerging Drugs (ISSED), the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), the European Monitoring Center for Drugs and Drug Addiction (EMCDDA), the World Agency for Anti-Doping (@wada\_ama) the University of Hertfordshire (UH), Pan American Regional Antidoping Organization (PAN-RADO) and the Panamanian Institute of Sports @pandeportes



The Conference took place in Panama in the capital city and lasted 3 days and was made up of participants in person and virtually.

Our official Sponsor of the event was PANDEPORTES as a sports Institution in Panama and Government and Sports Institutions also joined to support this great event, such as: National Assembly of Panama, PROMTUR, Vistit Panama, Senadis, among others.

### **Opening of the Genetix Laboratory based in Panama**



The World Anti-Doping Agency announced that its Executive Committee voted to approve the Genetix Clinical Laboratory, located in Panama City, Panama to exclusively perform blood tests in support of the Athlete Biological Passport (ABP).

Following the review process led by the WADA Science Department and the WADA Laboratory Expert Advisory Group, it was determined that the Laboratory had successfully completed the



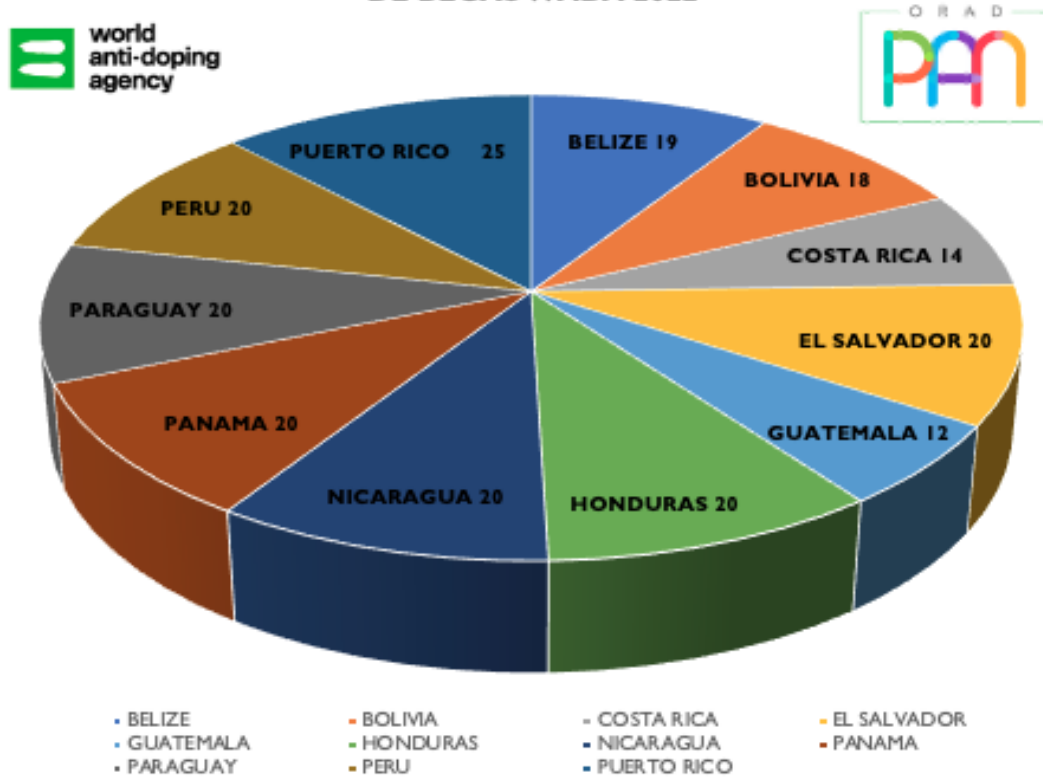
various technical and administrative steps of the WADA PBL approval process. established in the International Standard for Laboratories.

WADA Director General Olivier Niggli said: “WADA is pleased to count the Genetix Clinical Laboratory among its approved ABP laboratories. It was important to increase the analytical testing capacity for the ABP hematology module in the Central American, Caribbean and South American regions. The addition of another ABP laboratory will serve to provide another comprehensive testing resource in this part of the world. The region's national and regional anti-doping organizations are now better equipped to test athletes based in these regions.”

The Laboratory has arranged import permits with the National Customs Directorate of Panama and the courier services of COPA Airline (based in Panama and serving as a regional transportation hub) to facilitate the transportation of blood samples within the region. The Laboratory maintains that it will be possible to quickly transport samples from different countries in the region to its facilities, while complying with the specific time and temperature requirements required for PBL analyses.

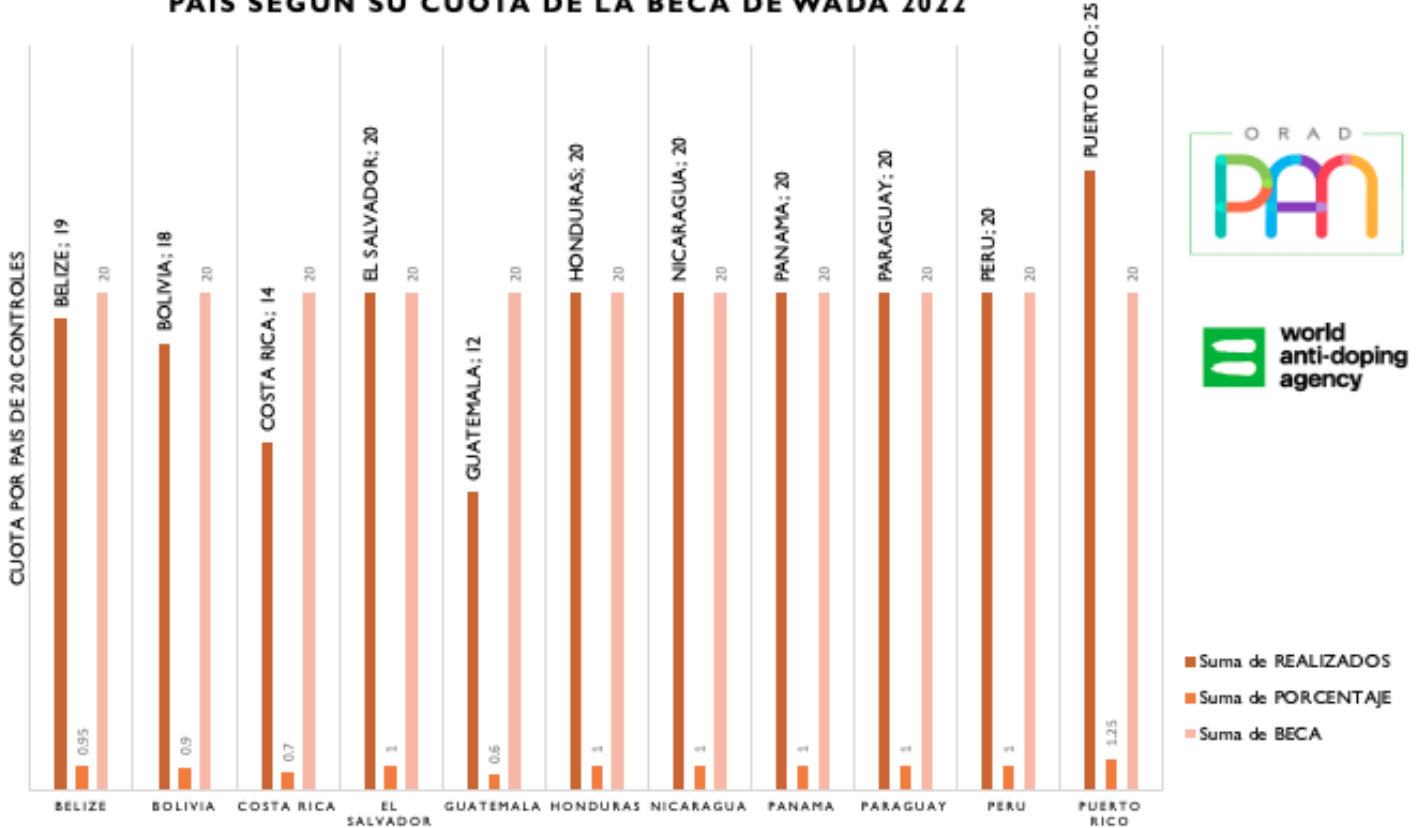

**CONTROLES ORADPAN REALIZADOS POR PAIS PROGRAMA DE BECAS WADA 2022**



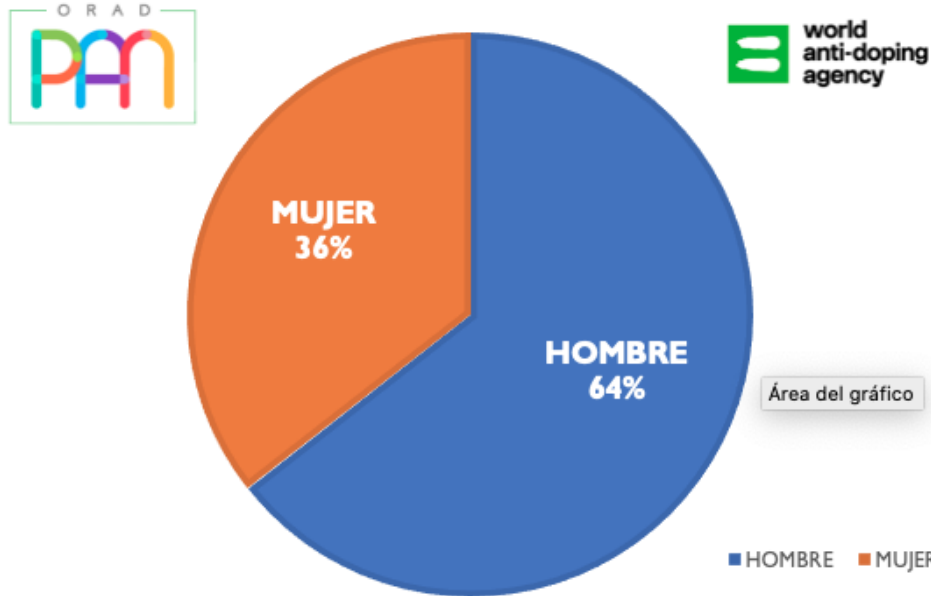
Graph 1: Shows the controls carried out by each of the member countries that are part of the WTG and TDP program of the World Anti-Doping Agency in the year 2022.

**CONTROLES REALIZADOS POR SEXO BECA 2022 ORADPAN**

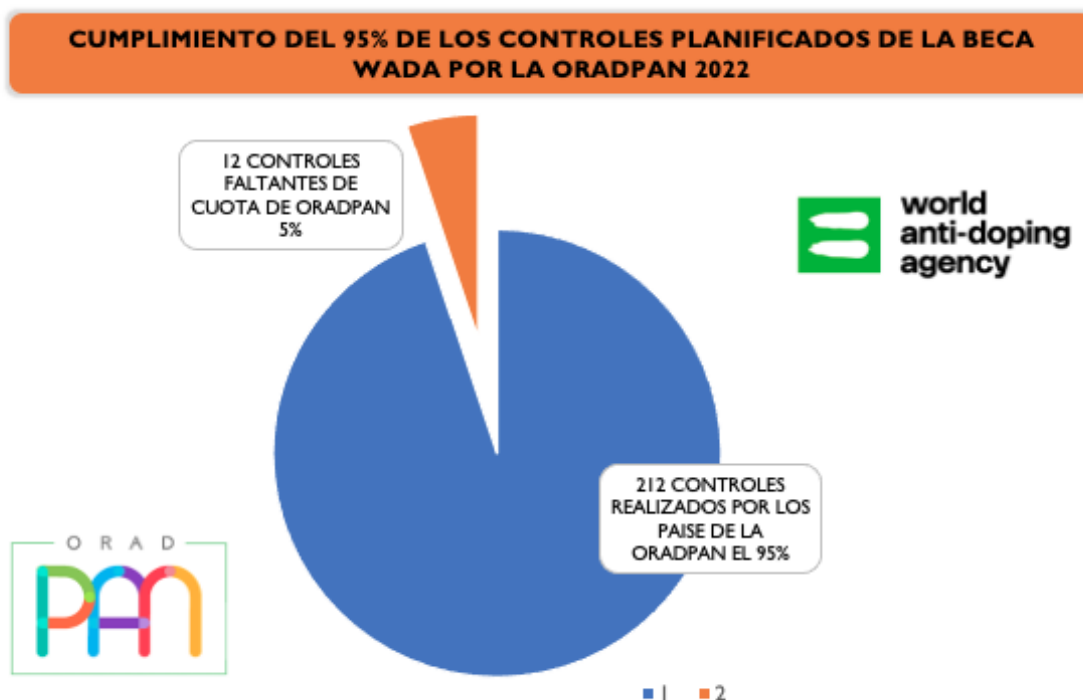


Graph 3: Shows the number of controls carried out according to sex. Throwing 64% for Men and 36% for women. These are results according to the WTG Testing by member countries.

## THERAPEUTIC USE EXCEPTION (TUE)

The management of requests for Exceptional Therapeutic Use Exception (TUE's) is carried out in athletes who, for health reasons, require the use of any substance(s) contemplated within the international standard "List of Prohibited Substances" issued by the World Anti-Doping Agency. (WADA). All requests received were addressed in compliance with the guidelines established by the World Anti-Doping Agency and the International Standard for Exceptional Therapeutic Use Exception.

Advice was given to all member countries on the management of TUE's. Similarly, guidance was provided to all athletes and members of the multidisciplinary group that required to know the regulations of the Exceptional Therapeutic Use Exception, international and in preparation for large events.

## **RELATIONSHIPS AND STRENGTHENING WITH NADO´s**

With the aim of supporting the development and compliance with the Code of the NADOs, provoking and managing interaction, training and exchange of knowledge with national and international organizations, the following activities were carried out:

- Multiple publications on doping and fair play issues have been made on social networks and dissemination of information on the website.
- Members and prospective members of the TUE panel in each country have received communications from the RADO.
- Constant communication has been maintained with all the countries of the region.
- The satisfaction questionnaire (quality) was applied to all the member countries of the PAN-RADO.
- A complaint follow-up mechanism has been implemented, which is available to each of the NADO´s.
- A meeting of all the RADOs was held in Sydney Australia with the purpose of exchanging knowledge and educational tools.
- We participated as an independent observer in the 2022 Brimingham World Games in Alabama in order to see the operation of both controls and the educational part for athletes and support personnel.
- New questionnaires were created for the NADOs to collect information on the Accreditations and Reaccreditations of officials and chaperones for doping control processes.
- A new questionnaire on blood viability for blood control processes was created.



### INTERNATIONAL AND NATIONAL COOPERATION

- As part of the bilateral cooperation project "Support for Anti-Doping Strengthening from the National Doping Control Commission (CNCD) - Chile to the National Anti-Doping Organization of Panama, (NADO-PAN)", executed by both institutions, a meeting was carried out at the end of 2022. Internship for 3 professional Doping Officials from Panama, who will be trained within the framework of the Pan American Games of Table Tennis and the National Rowing Games in Curauma. Previously, in Panama, a TA Mission of two professionals from the CNCD of Chile was carried out in September 2022 to update the regulations associated with doping controls.
- Agreement with El Salvador: Achieving the strengthening between both organizations for the future support of the different commitments that are presented.
- The Belize Anti-Doping Organization signed a cooperation agreement with the Anti-Doping Laboratory of Havana, Cuba.
- The Advisory Board meeting (SAN SALVADOR 2022) was held with the presence of representatives of member countries of the PAN-RADO, both face-to-face and virtual, for the strengthening of the NADOs and the exchange of ideas to strengthen the educational departments and of controls.
- The training of Control Officers was carried out by the PAN-RADO in both Puerto Rico and Belize.
- Certification of two Doping Control Officials in each country of the region as International Doping Control Official (IDCO) in the program endorsed by the International Control Agency (ITA) in collaboration with the Pan American Regional Anti-Doping Organization (PAN-RADO)
- Election of the president of PAN-RADO, Doctor Saúl Saucedo as representative of the Expert Advisory Group of Anti-Doping Organizations.

### CONCLUSIONS

As the Pan American Regional Anti-Doping Organization, we are truly pleased and proud of the work achieved in 2022, with 11 member countries and 3 strategic partners that have done hard work to comply with both education and controls.

During the year 2022 we were still in the process of elections in certain countries and even so at the end of the year it was possible to meet each of the objectives set for this year. Each educational department was strengthened and supported by us as PAN-RADO to educate our athletes in each of the commitments that were taking place throughout the year.

As PAN-RADO we are also proud of the new alliances and agreements reached in order to grow the Organization and receive the support of institutions and organizations that will surely contribute in a positive way the knowledge and experiences necessary to become one of the RADO's most complete worldwide.

The year 2023 will be a year of new challenges and opportunities, with great multidisciplinary events and great events such as the education congress in Argentina. We are convinced that, just as the year 2022 was successful, in the same way the year 2023 will be successful in each of the projects that are managed.
